The first fish to the scales was a 30.75#, 53" fish caught on the "Yellow Belly" by Joel Piatek. Next, Dave Helzer aboard the "Miss Megan", brought a 32.15#, 51 3/4" hog to the scales. Then, the "Cathy Sue" crew brought in a nice 51", 31.15# fish to the scales, the angler was Jimmy Trebilcock. The "Premonition" came rolling in at 1:45 with a 32.55#, 51 1/2" fish caught by Tony Ranella.

Then, 3:00 rolled around and the real hogs started eating. Kevin Wieczorek aboard "Zapped" brought in a 53 3/4", 34.70# fish that was good for second place in the derby. Right on Kevin's tail was Tony Virga aboard "Liquid Sedation". Tony's fish was an awesome 51 1/2", 35.05# beast. Tony's fish was the eventual derby winner!

Last, but not least, Team Bandit limped in on one motor with their 33.30#, 51 1/4" fish, caught by Russ Pilette. Russ' fish hung on for third place.

There were 9, True Trophy Release fish, with 5 of those being in the junior division.

In the junior division, Jimmy Trebilcock had a 50 1/2" fish, Alec Pascua also had a 50 1/2". Ray Williams had a 48" fish followed by Brendan Budzeak and Thomas Monte with bookend 42 inchers. Nice job guys!

In the adult division, Joel Piatek had a 53" hog, followed by Greg Virga with a 52" fish. David Clark had a 51 3/4" and Adam Heinrich had a 50 1/2" fish.

Rules Changes

At the January general membership meeting, two rules changes were introduced and voted into action:

3.1. M.O.M.C. shall not fish for Muskie for any reason out of season.

3.3. During the (5) monthly M.O.M.C. tournaments, each participating M.O.M.C. boat is restricted to a maximum of Eight (8) rods.

3.3.1. M.O.M.C. members must abide by Ontario, and Michigan law in regards to rod count.

Summer Release Tips

July is here, and, with its arrival, come the increased water temperatures that can make it hard to release muskie.

Make sure you have all your release equipment ready when boating a fish. Knipex mini bolt-cutters, jaw spreaders, long needle-nose pliers, Boga Grips and channel locks are all great tools. Have your cameras ready for a quick shot and try to keep the fish off of the boat floor.

If you don't have one already, a Fish ThANKS revival system is a vital piece of equipment. It has undoubtedly saved thousands of muskie since its invention by David Clark.
