The MOMC is once again teaming up with members of the Grosse Pointe Yacht Club, Detroit Yacht Club, and Detroit Athletic Club. Our goal this year is to raise \$10,000 for Special Olympics Michigan. The MOMC is looking for as many participants as possible. ### Who's Roger??

Sometimes people are a little shy about speaking on the VHF radio. They may feel kind of strange saying, "Over and out" or "Roger that, Big Guy". So, why do we say "roger"?

If you've ever heard a pilot talking, they don't use letters of the alphabet. Instead of saying "a-b-c", they say "alpha bravo charlie". This is the NATO alphabet and is used so critical combinations of letters (and numbers) can be pronounced and understood by those who transmit and receive voice messages by radio regardless of their native language.

"Roger" at one time was the phonetic designation for the letter R, which in turn stood for "received". Why not just say "received"? From a safety perspective, it makes sense to use standardized language in our global world. An American pilot may not understand German, but they both understand aviation terminology.

Prior to "roger", r equaled "rush". Roger took over in 1927. It gained its highest use when the Oxford English Dictionary included it in 1941, coinciding with the U.S entering WWII. In 1957 "roger was replaced by "romeo", the current designation, but by then "roger" = "received" was so entrenched that everyone knew better than to try and change it
