Release Tips

- Begin to fill live well/ fish box as soon as you realize you have a big fish on

- Once fish is boarded, transfer into live well as soon as possible

- Allow fish to calm down: use this time to quickly clean up boat & prepare for pictures

- Hold fish horizontally & take pictures quickly; place fish back into well

- When the fish is ready, lay it in the lake horizontally while gently holding its tail

- Allow the fish to swim off when it is ready

Homer LeBlanc Derby July 14-15

This year's Homer LeBlanc Derby was a huge success. The Shore Club, again, proved to be a wonderful host for this popular club tournament. The weather cooperated with the fishermen and, as a result, many nice fish were caught. The club would like to especially thank Jim Schiller, Greg Sultana, Greg Virga, Tristan Spindler and Tim and Chris Ardanowski, who combined for the fish fry preparation work Friday evening, Sunday afternoon fish frying, and Sunday evening clean-up. Thanks also to Rich Wolicki for preparing the wonderful fish dinner. A special thanks to the crew of Bait Runner for their help too!

Saturday started out with Anthony Ceerle aboard Yellow Belly bringing in a nice 50" fish weighing around 32.90 lbs. This set the pace for the rest of the day, with only one more fish being weighed at 8 pm Sat. evening. Steve Bacha fishing on Another Day brought in a 51 ¼" fish weighing 32.95 lbs. How close is that! Sunday morning the scales opened up at 8 am with Chris Michayluk of **Teeko** registering a 51 1/4" musky at 35.40 lbs. These fish held up for the top three in the registered division and all were also in the Homer LaBlanc side bet.

This tournament also proved to be spectacular for the True Trophy Release category. Seven fish were registered and all over 51" long! In many previous years 51" would have won the TTR category. It was a weekend of boats releasing multiple big fish! **Another Day's** Jason Gaca caught a 54" fish (1st place Adult) and Steve Bacha caught a 51 ½" fish. **Premonition's** Anthony Adams caught a 52 ¼" fish (2nd place Adult). **Impatient's** Kelly Jones caught a 52" and Blake Jones (1st place Junior) caught a 51 ½" fish. **Medicine Man's** Ed Pascua and Alec Pascua (2nd Place Junior) each caught 51" fish. Congratulations to the winners!

In addition to club recognition, the anglers of the first, second and third place registered muskie received memorabilia from Homer Lablanc's family. Kevin Bachus attended the fish fry and brought three items which President Rich Stoody distributed. They were an original print of a musky, a hand carved lure and a copy of Homer LaBlanc's book. (5) All entrants must comply with the M.O.M.C. rules & regulations.
