September 8th and 9th Joe Pierce Memorial Derby Report

For the last 3 years the September MOMC Tournament Fishing has been really tough and this year's Joe Pierce Memorial Derby was no exception. We had strong 15-20 mph northwest winds all day Saturday. People either tried to find a small area without floating weeds or they cleaned lines constantly! The only Saturday fish was registered late in the afternoon. It was caught by Frank Manzo on Shootout. The fish weighted 31.05 lbs and measured 49.5 lbs. with a 20.5" girth. Nice fish Frank!

Sunday was much better weather with winds at 5-10 mph and sunshine. Things got exciting the last two hours of the day as Dan Shank on Infinity pulled in a nice 30.70 lb. fish that was 50" long with a 20.5" girth. As the clock ticked down to the 2:00 PM deadline Team Medicine Man raced to the weigh station with a monster in the revival tank. They knew they had the winning fish on board if they could get it to the scales on time. The Lions scored the winning touchdown with 10 seconds left Sunday. Medicine Man arrived at the scales 7 minutes late and weighed in a tremendous 34+ lb. fish! Ed won first place in the Registered Release contest for the 51.5" fish.

Other anglers reported releasing nice fish up to 49 inches long.

Big Fish Report

It appears that the biggest fish in the lake were hiding for the September Tournament. Medicine Man found a large fish just as the Joe Pierce Memorial Derby ended on Sunday.
