Rule Changes

Section 1 Catching of a Muskie

RULE 1.2

Muskie must have obtained a minimum length of (52) inches OR obtained a minimum weight of (30) pounds to be eligible for registration.

Section IV- Eligibility For Prizes

RULE 4.2

Active professional muskie fishing guides, charter captains, and or their immediate family members, ARE eligible for top (5) recognition and prize money, assuming they meet the following criteria. Said muskie was caught during one of the (5) sanctioned M.O.M.C. monthly tournament weekends, while NOT FOR HIRE, and meet all requirements in order to be eligible for prizes during that tournament.

NO muskie registered by an active professional guide or charter captain or their immediate family, are eligible for cash prizes in the YEAR END SIDEBET.
